
CROSS-COUNTRY SKIING

- * Please note that trails are not groomed
- * Skiers are responsible for their own safety and are advised not to ski alone
- * As a safety precaution, sign in and out at the Corning Visitor Center
- * Skis are not permitted inside Arboretum buildings
- * Trails are accessible during open hours of 9am to 5pm
- * Stay on the posted ski trails; avoid main trails through the gardens

SNOWSHOEING

- * Snowshoers may traverse any snow-covered trails or fields
- * Suggested beginners' trail: Blueberry Pond Loop
- * For those who want a challenging hike: Corning Lake Loop or Layer Rhododendron Garden
- Stay away from garden beds and bodies of water, as both may be harder to spot when snow-covered
- * To keep trails safe for skiers, avoid walking on ski trails
- * Avoid walking on non-snow surfaces such as exposed concrete
