Despite increased action, our region is losing trees at an alarming rate—nearly **100 acres** of tree cover each year (due to factors such as pests, diseases, climate change, and human activity).

Together, we must plant and protect tens of thousands of trees to reverse the trends of tree loss in Northeast Ohio.



Trees provide numerous benefits to people and the environment. They cool and clean our air, filter our water, improve our health, bolster businesses, and add value to properties. Tree canopy is essential to the health and well-being of individuals and the community—it is essential green infrastructure.

#### **Yet not all neighborhoods equally benefit from trees.** Tree canopy is uneven across our region, tending to be

lowest in marginalized communities, including communities of color. Because of the many benefits that trees provide, planting and caring for trees is an important way that we can take action to help reduce health and social inequalities now and in the future.
